**KEY RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Engage with the Program Manager to understand key task requirements of :
  - Classifying worker survey questionnaires into a question bank. The intern will be provided with some basic rules of tagging and data labeling, with an opportunity to build on the existing work.
  - Researching and co-designing methodologies for surveying, scoring and assessing forced labour and modern slavery in supply chains
  - Assisting in gathering client feedback and ideas to inform platform advancements.
- Collaborate with the other team members to utilize their areas of expertise to perform the tasks better

- Social science background with knowledge, interest and/or experience in supply chains, corporate sourcing, ethical procurement, community relations and social impact, sustainability, international development, social impact tech, and/or business and human rights

- Fluency in English is mandatory; other languages are considered an advantage
