A portion of every sale is used to distribute LIFe products and services to communities in need.

### **THE POSITION**

The NGO/Institutional and Impact Programs intern reports to the Director of Programs and Impact. You will support Institutional/NGO and Impact projects and our operations in various ways including assisting with grant writing/research/reporting, case studies, programs strategy and support, sector-specific marketing activities and materials design and development.

### **Key Responsibilities**

- Research and case study development on iron deficiency interventions and Institutional/NGO programs.
- Identify innovative funding opportunities and grants for Lucky Iron Fish and its NGO/private sector partners.
- Research and outreach for potential new product materials.
- Collaborate with the marketing team to develop content, design projects and update existing marketing collateral for institutional and/or NGO programs. (e.g. sell sheets, price lists, brochures, images, presentations etc.).
- Create new assets (videos and photos) to be used across Lucky Iron Fish's multiple channels.
- Support current Institution/NGO programs as required, eg. training, reporting, etc.



### **Must-Haves**

- Degree in or pursuing a degree in Business, International Business or Equivalent
- Understanding of, and passion for, social enterprise and “business for good”
- Strong multitasker, and adaptable to shifting priorities.
- Strong organizational skills: does not let things fall through the cracks.
- Working knowledge of MS Office required and experience with G Suite tools, (especially Excel or G Sheets)
- Enrolled in a college or university.
- Be between 15 and 30 years of age (inclusive) at the time of intake/selection.
- Be legally able to work according to Ontario’s legislation and regulations.
